6 Steps in Guided Reading - Out of this World Literacy

The practice of guided reading is based on the belief that the optimal learning for a reader occurs when they are assisted by an educator, or expert 'other', to read and understand a text with clear but limited guidance. Guided reading allows students to practise and consolidate effective reading strategies.

A chance to meet the needs of all children in your classroom. In Guided Reading, you meet with groups of up to six children at a time who are reading at similar reading levels. A time to support children as they take on more challenging texts. During Guided Reading, children read from the same instructional level texts.

What are best practices for making it work in my classroom? Here are the basic guidelines: Teacher works with small groups, ideally 3-6 students. Students are grouped according to their current reading level and are working on most of the same skills.

Supporting Students' Reading In working with students in guided reading, you constantly balance the difficulty of the text with support for students reading the text.
