Mentoring Versus Coaching: What's the Difference?

Mentoring has significant positive effects on two early warning indicators that a student may be falling off-track: High levels of absenteeism (Kennelly & Monrad, 2007) Students who meet regularly with their mentors are 52% less likely than their peers to skip a day of school and 37% less likely to skip a class.
